### ***Academic Overview***

The academic year commenced on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025, with a thriving strength of 1,470 students, nurtured by the dedicated efforts of 100 committed teachers and supported by 48 efficient non-teaching staff members, all working in unison to uphold the ethos of our institution.

In alignment with the CBSE framework and the principles of competency-based learning, a Bridge Course for Classes I to IX was conducted from 5<sup>th</sup> June to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025, ensuring a smooth academic transition and reinforcing foundational concepts.

This tradition was once again upheld as our students achieved a cent per cent pass result in both Class X and Class XII CBSE Board Examinations (2024–2025), a testimony to their perseverance, discipline, and scholarly rigour.

**Class X (SSE):** Out of **133** students, **6** students secured **A1** in all subjects, **104** students achieved Distinction, while the remaining students secured First Class, marking a resounding academic triumph.

**Class XII (SSCE):** Of the **150** students who appeared, **12** students earned **A1** in all subjects, **105** students secured Distinction, and the rest achieved First Class, reaffirming our academic excellence across streams.

This remarkable success is the fruit of tireless dedication—the steadfast commitment of our teachers, the visionary guidance of our management, the unwavering support of parents, and the relentless efforts of our students.

### ***Talent Search Examination***

Our students brought laurels to the institution by delivering an outstanding performance in the **Talent Search Examination 2024–25**, organised by **Kochi Metro Sahodaya for Classes I–VIII**, which witnessed the participation of **45** schools and over 1,500 young aspirants.

**Fadhiya Azmin V** (Grade II) emerged First, earning a medal, certificate, and a cash award of **₹5,000/-**, showcasing exceptional academic promise at a very young age. **Sahabia Filza Dishar** (Class VII) secured Third Position, winning a medal, certificate, and a cash award of **₹2,000/-** reflecting her diligence, perseverance, and scholastic excellence.

These commendable achievements stand as shining examples of early academic brilliance and are a matter of immense pride for the school.

our students actively participated in various prestigious competitive examinations such as the Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF), the Indian Talent Olympiad (ITO), the Green Olympiad conducted by the Energy and Resources Institute, the Sugama Hindi Examination conducted by Sugama Hindi Prachar Sabha, the PCM Scholarship Examination conducted by PCM Publishers, and the Quiz Competition conducted by H&C Publishers.

Through their consistent efforts and intellectual curiosity, our students secured several medals and certificates, reaffirming our commitment to nurturing academic excellence, competitive spirit, and holistic development.

### ***Annual Events***

**Merit Day**, a celebration of scholastic excellence, was observed on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2025, honouring our exemplary CBSE Board achievers. The awards were graciously presented by Hon’ble Justice Shri Haroon Al Rasheed, Former Judge, High Court of Kerala.

**Class X Topper: Naira Mahzin (X D)** with an outstanding **98.6%**, along with centum scorers in Malayalam, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, and IT.

**Class XII Toppers: Hizana T. M. (XII B)** and **Pranav Peringeth (XII D)** with **97.8%**, **Ashifa C. (XII C)** with **97.2%**, emerging as the Commerce stream topper.

Several students achieved centum scores in Psychology, Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science, and Economics.
